The FEEL GREEN partnership is proud to announce the successful completion of the project's educational material and the development of the FEEL GREEN E-Handbook, marking another important milestone in the implementation of the project. Following the completion of the research and methodological phase, the consortium focused on transforming research findings, sustainability methodologies, and educational approaches into practical and accessible learning resources for youth workers, educators, and young people across Europe.

The newly developed educational material was designed to strengthen sustainability awareness, energy-efficiency knowledge, and green competences through non-formal education and interactive learning approaches. The material includes educational activities, participatory exercises, workshop methodologies, awareness-raising tools, and practical learning resources that can support youth workers in implementing sustainability-oriented educational initiatives within their local communities and organisations.



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A central outcome of this phase is the FEEL GREEN E-Handbook, which has now been officially completed and published on the project's website. The handbook was developed as a practical educational resource that combines sustainability knowledge, good practices, and real-life examples connected to environmental awareness, green skills, energy efficiency, and youth participation. Through its accessible and learner-centered structure, the handbook aims to support both individual learning and the implementation of educational activities within youth work environments.

One of the most important elements of the E-Handbook is the inclusion of good practices and case studies from all three partner countries — Greece, Slovakia, and Luxembourg. These examples highlight local sustainability initiatives, community-based actions, environmental education practices, and innovative approaches related to climate awareness and green transition. By presenting different national experiences and perspectives, the handbook promotes European cooperation, exchange of knowledge, and the transfer of successful sustainability practices across diverse educational and social contexts.



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The FEEL GREEN Educational Material includes four comprehensive educational modules that guide participants through different dimensions of sustainability, energy efficiency, climate awareness, behavioral change, and digital engagement. The educational content was developed using learner-centered and non-formal education approaches designed to encourage critical thinking, participation, reflection, and practical application of sustainability concepts in everyday life.

Module 1, “Energy, Sustainability & Climate Reality”, helps participants understand how modern energy systems shape our societies, contribute to climate change, and why energy efficiency is essential for a sustainable future. **Module 2, “Understanding Energy Consumption in Daily Life”**, focuses on daily habits, hidden energy use, and practical actions that influence sustainability and responsible energy consumption. **Module 3, “Understanding Green Skills & Sustainability Mindset”**, supports the development of critical thinking, practical green competences, and the confidence needed to apply sustainability principles in real-life situations and inspire collective environmental action.



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The educational journey concludes with **Module 4, which explores the relationship between digital tools, platforms, user experience, gamification, and community engagement in promoting sustainable behavior and energy efficiency.** The module demonstrates how digital technologies and interactive online environments can support environmental awareness, responsible energy use, and long-term behavioral change within modern digital societies.

The educational material and the E-Handbook were developed with a strong emphasis on inclusion, accessibility, participation, and practical applicability. The resources are designed to support youth workers, educators, trainers, NGOs, and young people with practical tools that can be adapted to different learning environments, participant profiles, and community realities. In addition, the materials encourage critical thinking, active citizenship, collaboration, and environmentally responsible behavior among young people.
